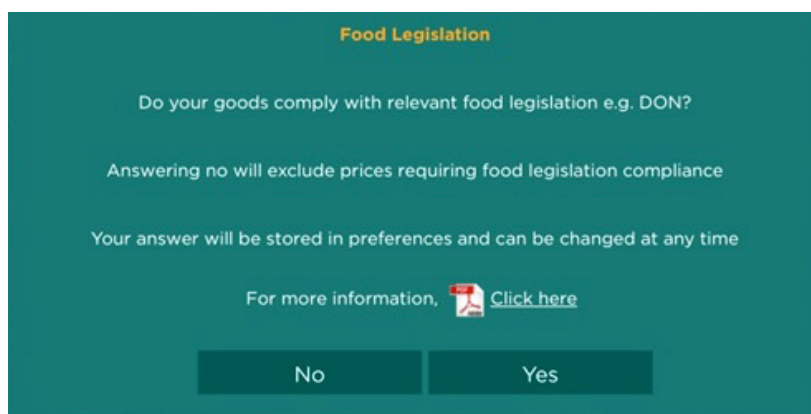

Keep close to the grain markets

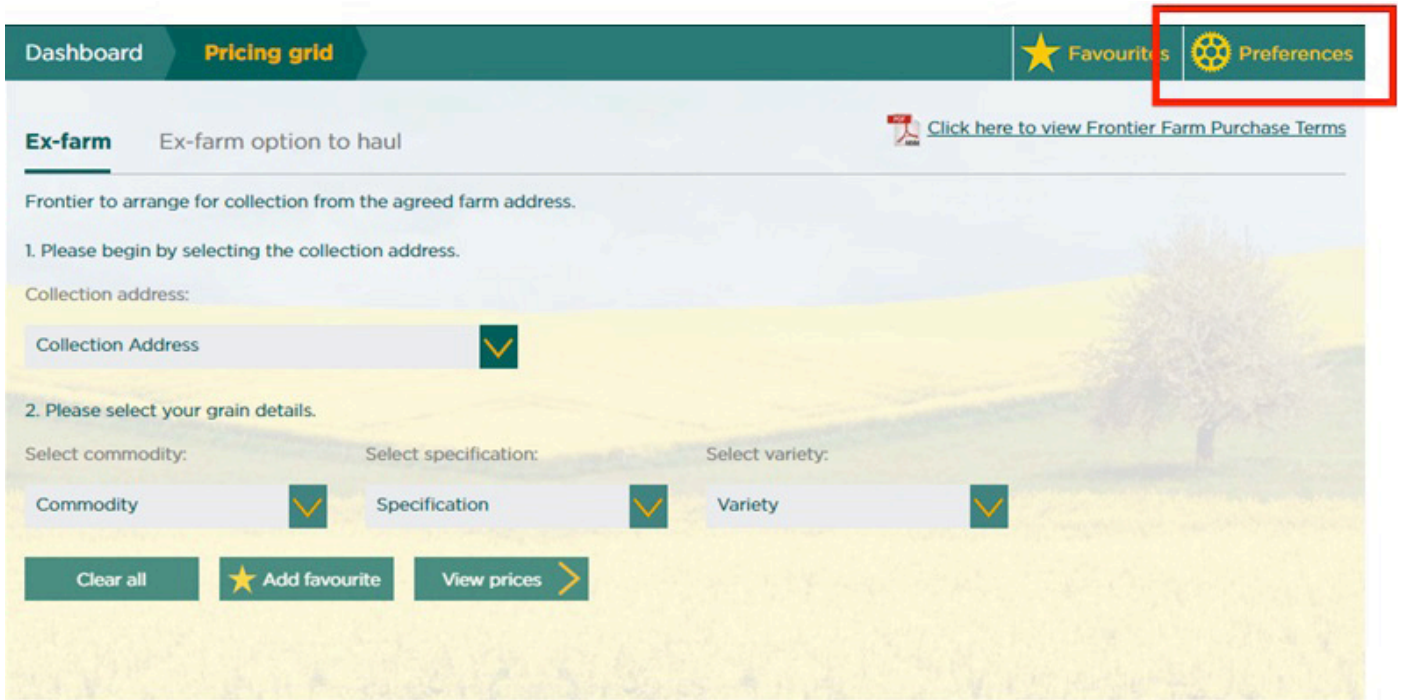
When you first logged into [MyCropMarketing](#) via the [MyFarm](#) dashboard, you will have been presented with a screen asking for your commodity preferences:



The preferences that are stored will influence the grain prices that you are shown. As a result, it is worth checking they are up to date. You can do this by clicking either 'Sell grain' or 'Set price alert' when in MyCropMarketing:



After this, select 'Preferences' in the top right of the screen:

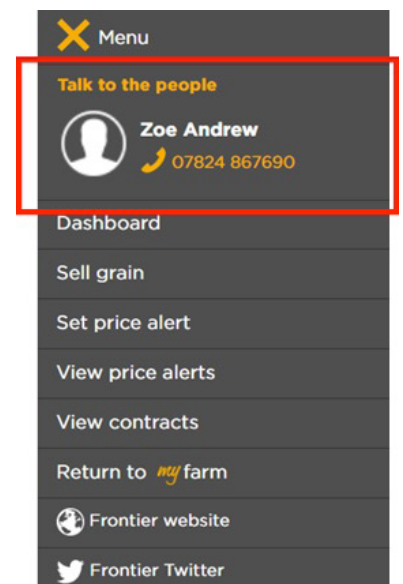


This will allow you to check and edit any of your saved preferences, as shown in the below example:

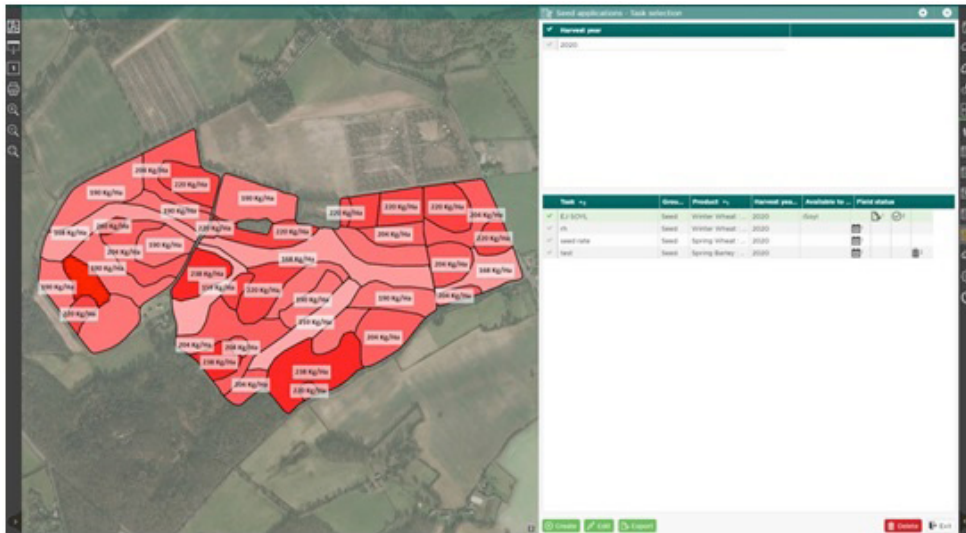
Alternatively, if you return to the main dashboard in MyCropMarketing and select the menu icon in the top left, you will be able to see your farm trader's contact information to gain extra market insight and trading advice.




Adjusting a seed plan

It's simple to adjust an existing seed plan in [MySOYL](#) and it can be especially useful for those times when you need to tweak the target rate to reflect seasonal changes and soil conditions.

To get started, simply open the 'Seed applications' tool and select the tick box next to the plan you want to change (it will highlight the row green). Next, instead of selecting 'Create' to start a plan, simply select 'Edit'.



This will re-open your selected plan, allowing you to make your desired alterations. If you are using [iSOYL](#), any fields that have been marked as drilled are shown with a green tick and are locked for editing. If you want to change these fields, simply un-tick the box.
