
The new MyMarkets component within MyFarm now replaces the futures pricing that was available via iTRAC and the Frontier app and is fully responsive across all mobile devices.

Exploring the areas in MyMarkets

To access MyMarkets, you will need [to log into MyFarm](#) and enter your credentials.

From the Dashboard you can navigate to two different areas of MyMarkets: 'Market Report' and 'Exchange Rate'.



'Market Report' allows you to view Frontier's Market Report, which gives updates on activity in the grain markets.

- **USDA shocks markets**

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) surprised markets at the end of March 2020 when it published its US quarterly stocks and acreage report. It estimated that US farmers would significantly expand their corn planted area. The estimate predicted the planted corn area would be 7.3 million acres greater than last year, when prolonged rainfall kept farmers out of the fields.

Using this data, the USDA, in its first world supply and demand estimates for 2020/21, increased the US corn crop estimate by 59 million tonnes on the year, bringing the total to 406 million tonnes. It also increased year-end stocks by 31 million tonnes, bringing this total to 84 million tonnes - the highest production volume since 1983.

The prospect of plentiful US corn crops has been a major bearish factor for world wheat markets in recent weeks, particularly considering that drilling has been completed in good time and the developing crop is in very good condition.

Log into MyFarm

MySOYL-GLGM link - Matching field names

As we approach harvest, many of you will be looking ahead to next year's cropping plans. Through the Greenlight Grower Management (GLGM) - MySOYL integration, it is now easier than ever to get your cropping information into MySOYL. When you are importing your cropping information from GLGM to MySOYL, you will need to match up your fields to ensure the right information is imported into MySOYL and is assigned to the correct field.

When you are importing fields from GLGM, MySOYL will first automatically attempt to spatially match fields based upon their boundaries within each system, as you can see below.

But if you don't have the spatial boundaries set up, that isn't a problem. MySOYL will also match fields based on their names. When it does this, you may notice - as in the below - that it has matched two fields within MySOYL with similar names to one field within GLGM.

If these two MySOYL fields do both correspond to the same Greenlight Field because, for example, previously Quarry was split into Bottom Quarry and Quarry but you now farm it as one, you can leave it as it is and MySOYL will import the same cropping information for both MySOYL Fields as you can see above.

However, if this isn't the case, you may want to only import one of the fields into MySOYL. In this case, simply un-tick the field that you don't want to import.

If you know that one of the fields has a different name within your GLGM account, by clicking on the name in the Greenlight Field column, you can select the correct field from a list of your GLGM fields.

It is always worth double checking all your fields have been correctly matched before you import them to save you time later in the season.

Remember, if you update your cropping in GLGM, you will need to re-import it into MySOYL.
