As the year starts to unfold, thoughts turn to the new season. This week's Tips & Tricks covers two practical areas within [MyFarm](#). Firstly, grouping fields together in [MySOYL](#) which can be used for many reasons including nitrogen applications. Secondly, managing recorded activities in Greenlight Grower Management (GLGM); something which will certainly be happening across the country very soon.


Working with Field Groups

We often group fields together beyond just the farm they are on or the crop they are in. It might be that a handful of the oilseed rape fields had muck pre-drilling and you want to keep track when it comes to applying bagged nitrogen in the spring. You can achieve this by creating a 'Field Group'.

Fields can be grouped together from the MySOYL home screen. Simply select your fields:

✓ Field ▲	Farm	Crop	ha
✓ Footpath	Welford Park Estate	Winter Wheat	11.62
✓ Gravel Pits	Welford Park Estate	Winter Wheat	20.69
✓ Pit Kiln	Welford Park Estate	Winter Wheat	7.3

Enter a relevant group name and click 'Save':

It will then appear within the 'Group' box so you can use it every time you use MySOYL. If selected, it will filter the map to show the fields within your group.

You can add new fields, change the name or delete the group by selecting 'Edit':

Editing recorded activities in Greenlight Grower Management

Once an activity has been confirmed in GLGM, sometimes there is a need to edit it. The permissions for who can edit an activity are held within GLGM by the person that confirmed the application. If required this can be amended, as shown below.

In the GLGM dashboard select 'Site Settings':
