How to add cropping to multiple fields

It's the time of year when crops are being drilled, which means it's time to make sure your crop recording systems are up to date for a new digital year.

To begin, select the relevant cropping year from the crops tab. You can do this by amending the season filter on the right-hand side of the screen.

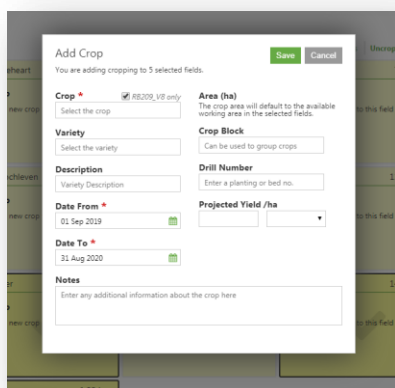
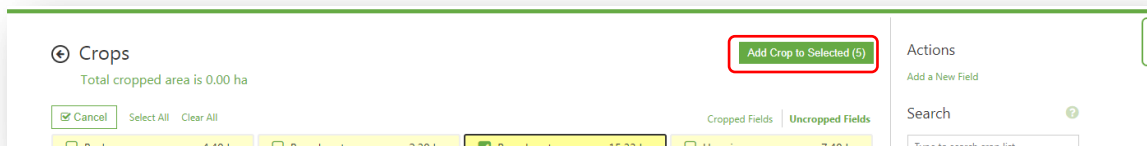

You can then use the 'Select button' on the top left to choose relevant fields. Pressing this button will make check boxes appear next to each field. Check the boxes next to the fields you'd like to add cropping to.



Once you've chosen all the relevant fields, click the green 'Add Crop to Selected' button on the top right of the screen.



You will then be able to add the cropping details to all of your selected fields at once, as shown on the left.

How to change establishment scenarios in MySOYL

When you create a new seed plan within the Seed Applications module, MySOYL will automatically select your default establishment scenario, which is based upon the results of your soil survey. While many growers are happy to use these scenarios, on occasion you may want to create and use your own custom scenarios due to changes in soil and weather conditions or perhaps because drilling has been delayed.

If you have created a custom scenario you would like to use, it is a simple process to change this within your seed plan. You simply need to click in the table under the scenario column where it says “Default”. You will then see a dropdown of all your available scenarios to choose from.
